Our religion advises every Muslim to meet their brothers in humanity well and to tell them that he loves them to make them happy. In the hadith, "a kind word is charity." "It is charity/good that a Muslim meets his brother with a cheerful face. And God commanded those who give charity to the poor and needy to say a good word to them that would make them happy. Allah says: "Kind words and the covering of faults are better than charity followed by injury. Allah is self-sufficient and forbearing." (Al-Baqarah, 263)
