Be kind to the parents

Honoring the parents

Allah **commanded** people to be kind to their parents in many verses in the Holy Qur'an. Allah says: "Worship Allah and associate nothing with Him, and to parents do good" (Al-Nisaa, 36) And Allah also says: "The Lord had decreed that you worship none but Him, and that you be kind to parents. **Whether one or both of them attain old age in thy life, say not to them a word of contempt, nor repel them, but address them in terms of honour.**" (Allsraa, 23)

The right of God Almighty over His servants is that they worship Him alone, then comes after that the right of the creation, and the first of these rights is the right of parents, and Allah commanded us to talk to them and treat them with kindness.
